**Minutes & Action Items from December 1, 2010:**

The minutes from the December 1, 2010 conference call were distributed on December 13, 2010.

It was noted that the minutes on the CNA website are still draft, but that no comments have been received concerning those minutes. It was asked if the minutes can be finalized.

Agreement was reached to finalize the minutes from December 1, 2010 as written.

**Action Items:**

- 1) Peter Lang, Rogers Communications, will discuss the costs of a simultaneous Boundary Extension Overlay or an Overlay in NPA 289/905, followed by a Boundary Extension Overlay in the NPA 289/416/647/905 regions and will report back, at a high level, to the Relief Planning Committee.

**Points Noted:**

Peter Lang reported that there are some marginal savings for Rogers Communications, but they are not significant from Rogers Communications' perspective.

- 2) NPA 416/647 Relief Planning Committee participants will review the description of item C (Level of Carrier Costs) in the assessment table contained in section 7 of the Planning Document and be prepared to discuss the examples during the next conference call.

**Post Meeting Note:** Action item #2 was discussed during today's conference call and some modifications were made to section 7 of the Planning Document.

**Contributions:**

It was noted that, although it has never been discussed, a Bell Canada contribution comprising a draft NPA 416/647 Relief Implementation Plan was submitted for consideration by the Relief Planning Committee on December 8, 2010.

In addition, on December 13, 2010 Bell Canada sent in a contribution suggesting revisions to Section 11 (Jeopardy Contingency Plan), Item 15 of the Planning Document.

It was noted that both these contributions were distributed to the NPA 416/647 Relief Planning Committee on December 13, 2010.

**Relief Implementation Schedule:**

It was noted that the NPA 416/647 Projected Exhaust Date is now forecast for May 2015, which moves the Projected Exhaust Date in by five months from the July 2010 R-NRUF result of October 2015.

It was noted that on April 7, 2011 Bell Canada had sent out a revised Relief Implementation Schedule which should be used as a contribution for discussion during the next conference call. The revised Relief Implementation Schedule accommodates the 5 month advance in the Projected Exhaust Date.

It was noted that Bell Canada would like to establish a new Relief Date of May 3, 2014 as opposed to the original October 18, 2014 Relief Date.

It was noted that, if the revised Relief Implementation Schedule is accepted, then some of the text in the draft Relief Implementation Plan will have to be adjusted.

It was noted that all three contributions are from Bell Canada and that no-one from Bell Canada is on today's conference call. It was asked whether there was any objection to reviewing the Bell Canada contributions during today's conference.

Agreement was reached to review the Bell Canada contributions during today's conference call even though no-one from Bell Canada is in attendance.

It was noted that no Telecommunications Alliance has been formed for NPA 416/647 at this time but there is a high probability that a Telecommunications Alliance will be formed to enable introduction of the new area code.

**Relief Implementation Plan:**

Doug Birdwise from Bell Canada joined the conference call for the second hour and presented the Bell Canada contributions for the Relief Implementation Plan and schedule.

It was noted that since the Planning Document has not yet been submitted to the Commission and, consequently, no decision concerning the Relief Method or Relief Date has been made, certain wording in the Relief Implementation Plan would have to be changed if the Relief Planning Committee intends to send the Planning Document and Relief Implementation Plan into the Commission simultaneously.
