**Welcome:**

The Chair of the CSCN welcomed the attendees.

It was noted that the purpose of today's conference call is to discuss the December 2008 NPA 450 J-NRUF Aggregate Results.

**Minutes from January 30, 2009 CSCN Conference Call**

It was noted that in the absence of the CSCN Secretary, the draft January 30, 2009 CSCN conference call minutes would not be discussed or finalized in today's teleconference.

**NPA 450 J-NRUF**

It was noted that the original draft NPA 450 J-NRUF Aggregate Results have been corrected to reflect the current November 2010 Projected Exhaust Date, in response to discussions at the February 11, 2009 NPA 450 Relief Planning Committee (RPC) teleconference. The CSCN Chair noted that the current version of the draft results was endorsed by the RPC and believed that no further changes were required.

Agreement was reached to consider the current draft December 2008 NPA 450 J-NRUF Aggregate Results as final.

It was noted that Telecom PN CRTC 2008-17 required that 7 CO Codes be set aside for Initial Code assignments after relief and 10 CO Codes be set aside for Initial Code assignments for New Entrants only after relief. It was queried as to what the effect would be on the RPC's recommended NPA Relief Date if the Commission did not endorse the RPC's recommendation to include the 7 CO codes above or the other 17 CO Codes, corresponding to Future Canadian Geographic NPA Codes, as available for assignment in a Jeopardy Condition.

It was suggested that the CRTC would direct an earlier Relief Date corresponding to the reduction in CO Codes available for assignment.

It was noted that if the 7 CO Codes as set out in the CRTC PN are not made available, then Projected Exhaust Date will advance as follows:

PED as per Guidelines - October 2010

PED as per the RPC Recommendations - December 2010.
