Welcome and Introductions:

Glenn Pilley welcomed the attendees and each of the participants introduced themselves. It was asked whether there were any administrative items that needed to be discussed before getting to the substance of the meeting.

November 12, 2008 Minutes & Action Items:

It was noted that the November 12, 2008 minutes were distributed to the NPA 613 Relief Planning Committee on November 17, 2008. It was asked whether participants have had a chance to review the minutes and whether they could be finalized on today's conference call.

Agreement was reached to approve the November 12, 2008 conference call minutes, as written.

Action Items:

- 4) The NPA 613 RPC Chair will inform the Consumer Awareness Task Force of the need to advise businesses in the affected NPA of the new area code and of the requirement to alert the entire populace of the presence of the new area code

when 343 CO Codes become active, and will ensure that the CATF is capable of addressing these issues. **(Ongoing)**

Agenda:

Modifications to NPA 613 Relief Implementation Plan:

The Relief Planning Committee reviewed the remaining changes showing in the most recent version of the draft NPA 613 Relief Implementation Plan. During this review, detailed minute taking was suspended.

Agreement was reached to accept the updated NPA 613 Relief Implementation Plan as modified during today's conference call. The Relief Implementation Plan has been updated in accordance with Telecom Decision CRTC 2008-89. This version of the RIP will be considered final and will be transmitted to the CISC and CRTC for approval.
