**Joint NPA 250 and NPAs 403/780 RPC/CSCN Conference Call**  
**January 2006 R-NRUF Results**

**Welcome:**

The Chair of the Relief Planning Committees welcomed the attendees and the participants introduced themselves.

**Agenda:**

It was noted that no formal agenda had been provided for today's conference call, but that the purpose of the call is to review the aggregate January 2006 Relief Planning Numbering Resource Utilization Forecast (January 2006 R-NRUF) results for NPAs 250, 403 and 780, which were distributed to the CSCN on April 7, 2006 and were posted to the CNA website.

**January 2006 R-NRUF Results:**

Suresh Khare presented the NPA 250 January 2006 R-NRUF result and compared it to the January 2005 and July 2005 R-NRUF results. It was noted that the Projected Exhaust Date has moved out by one month from the July 2005 R-NRUF result. The Projected Exhaust Date for NPA 250 is now April 2010.

It was noted that NPA 250 is still well within the Relief Planning timeframe.

It was noted that a Relief Planning meeting needs to be held to continue development of the Planning Document and a relief plan for submission to and approval by the CRTC.

It was also suggested that a meeting be postponed until after the July 2006 R-NRUF results are published and that a meeting could then be scheduled for the autumn of 2006.

Suresh Khare presented the NPA 403 January 2006 R-NRUF result and compared it to the January 2005 and July 2005 R-NRUF results. It was noted that the Projected Exhaust Date has moved in by four months from the July 2005 R-NRUF result. The Projected Exhaust Date for NPA 403 is now March 2011.

It was noted that NPA 403 is still well within the Relief Planning timeframe.

It was noted that a Relief Planning meeting needs to be held to continue development of the Planning Document and a relief plan for submission to and approval by the CRTC.

It was also suggested that a meeting be postponed until after the July 2006 R-NRUF results are published and that a meeting could then be scheduled for the autumn of 2006.

Suresh Khare presented the NPA 780 January 2006 R-NRUF result and compared it to the January 2005 and July 2005 R-NRUF results. It was noted that the Projected Exhaust Date has moved in by two years over the last twelve months. The Projected Exhaust Date for NPA 780 is now February 2013, which is currently just inside the relief planning window.

It was suggested that if the Projected Exhaust Date continues to advance at the current rate, then the NPA 780 Projected Exhaust Date could catch up to that of NPA 403. It was concluded from this conjecture that relief planning for NPAs 403 and 780 should continue to be conducted in parallel and that the next RPC meeting should be held coincident with the RPC meeting for NPA 403.

The Chair thanked the attendees for their participation on the conference call.

**Summary of Agreements Reached:**

- 1) Agreement was reached to accept the aggregate January 2006 R-NRUF results for NPAs 250, 403 and 780.
- 2) Agreement was reached to review the July 2006 R-NRUF results and then set a date for two Relief Planning meetings in western Canada during the autumn of 2006.

**Summary of Action Items:**

- 1) The CNA will ensure that the final aggregate results on the CNA website are the results discussed during today's conference call.
