Welcome and Introductions:

Glenn Pilley welcomed the attendees of the Joint NPA 250, 403 & 780 Relief Planning Committees' conference call, and each of the participants introduced themselves.

Approval of Agenda:

It was noted that a formal agenda for today's Joint Relief Planning Committee (RPC) conference call had not been developed, but that the purpose of this conference call is to continue reviewing and finalizing the Relief Implementation Plan for NPAs 250 and 403/780.

Review of July 9, 2007 Conference Call Minutes & Action Items:

It was noted that the minutes from the July 9, 2007 Joint NPA 250, 403 and 780 Relief Planning Committees conference call were distributed to the NPA 250 and NPA 403/780 Relief Planning Committee participants on July 12, 2007.

It was asked whether the minutes could be approved and finalized during today's conference call.

Agreement was reached to accept the July 9, 2007 Joint NPA 250, 403 and 780 Relief Planning Committee conference call minutes, as written.

Action Items:

- 1) Kevin McGouran will check to find out whether Anne Gertzbein will be the MTS Allstream Consumer Awareness Task Force representative. **(Outstanding)**
- 2) Sam Haigh will provide a copy of the updated tariff page for Good Hope Lake to the CNA once it has been filed. **(Outstanding)**

- 3) Shawn Hall informed the CATF of the requirement for all Telecom Service Providers to develop and file individual consumer awareness programs with the CRTC. At that time, it was noted that this will probably be done collectively by the Western Telecommunications Alliance.
- 4) The Consumer Awareness Task Force has recommended some changes to a few of the dates for customer communications shown in the Relief Implementation Schedule. These will be reviewed during today's conference call.
- 5) The Network Implementation Task Force held a conference call on July 18, 2007 and tentatively agreed with the dates that have been inserted into the Relief Implementation Schedule.
- 6) The Consumer Awareness Task Force should be communicating the requirement for 10-digit local dialing in British Columbia and Alberta to the alarm companies since, typically, it seems the alarm companies require more time to make the change from 7- to 10-digits.
- 7) Volunteers for test CO Codes are required in NPA 587. On the July 9, 2007 TELUS was the only participant to indicate they would apply for a test CO Code. **(Outstanding)**
- 8) A TIF Report needs to be drafted to serve as a transmittal document for the Relief Implementation Plan to the CISC and CRTC.

With respect to Action Item #5, it was noted that the Network Implementation Task Force has suggested changes to item 39 and 40 in the Relief Implementation Schedule, based on input from Task Force members that was provided after the July 18, 2007 conference call.

With respect to Action Item #7, it was noted that Rogers is checking to see whether they can apply for a test CO Code in NPA 587.

It was noted that, during the July 9, 2007 Joint Planning Committee conference call, an agreement had been reached that the any historical dates that need to be added to the Relief Implementation Schedule will be completed by the CNA without consultation with the Joint NPA 250, 403 and 780 Relief Planning Committees.

Post Conference Call Note: *The historical dates have been included in the Relief Implementation Schedule.*

Relief Implementation Plan for NPAs 250, 403 & 780:

Detailed minute taking was suspended while the latest version of the Relief Implementation Plan and associated Attachments were being reviewed and edited.

Agreement was reached to accept the NPA 250, 403 & 780 Relief Implementation Plan, as modified during today's conference call.

Agreement was reached to forward the NPA 250, 403 & 780 Relief Implementation Plan to the CISC for approval.

Agreement was reached to request the CISC Secretary and Chair to schedule a CISC walkaround meeting to approve the NPA 250, 403 & 780 Relief Implementation Plan by August 17, 2007 prior to forwarding it to the Commission for approval.

TIF Report:

It was noted that since the Joint NPA 250, 403 and 780 Relief Planning Committees have finalized the NPA 250, 403 and 780 Relief Implementation Plan, a TIF Report needs to be drafted to serve as a transmittal document for the Relief Implementation Plan to the CISC and CRTC.

It was also noted that the CNA had drafted a TIF Report but that it had not been distributed to the NPA 250, 403 and 780 Relief Planning Committee participants. A copy was distributed to the conference call participants during the course of the conference call.

The conference call participants reviewed the draft TIF Report.

It was noted that this TIF Report is TIF Report #1 from the Joint Relief Planning Committees for NPAs 250, 403 & 780.

Agreement was reached to send the TIF Report and the Relief Implementation Plan for NPAs 250, 403 and 780 to the CISC Secretary and Chair on July 26, 2007.

Planning Letter for NPA 587:

It was noted that a draft Planning Letter for NPA 587 had been posted to the CNA's website on June 28, 2007. The conference call participants reviewed and modified the Planning Letter.

Agreement was reached to accept the Planning Letter as modified during today's conference call and to send it forward to NANPA for posting once the Relief Implementation Plan and TIF Report have been sent to Commission staff on July 26, 2007.

It was noted that TELUS would apply for NPA-NXX 587-610 to use as a test CO Code.

It was noted that the Planning Letter would have to be modified to include Rogers' test numbers, if they do apply for a test CO Code.

Next Meeting/Conference Call:

- 6) The CNA will send a copy of the NPA 587 Planning Letter to NANPA for posting once the Relief Implementation Plan and TIF Report have been sent to Commission staff.
