To: Current and Prospective Canadian Central Office (CO) Code Holders in NPAs 204 and 705

Subject: Inputs required for October 2010 Jeopardy Numbering Resource Utilization Forecasts (J-NRUFs)

Section 8.1 of the Canadian NPA Relief Planning Guideline details the circumstances under which the Canadian Numbering Administrator (CNA) will declare a Jeopardy Condition.

As a result of the provisions contained in section 8.1, on 13 May 2009 based on the results of the April 2009 Relief Planning Numbering Resource Utilization Forecast (R-NRUF), the CNA announced that NPA 705 was in a Jeopardy Condition. Finally, after analysis of the January 2010 G-NRUF, the CNA announced on 5 May 2010 that NPA 204 has also come back into a Jeopardy Condition.

In accordance with section 8.2 of the Canadian NPA Relief Planning Guideline and section 3, item 3 of the Canadian Numbering Resource Utilization Forecast (C-NRUF) Guideline, the CNA is required to request a Jeopardy Numbering Resource Utilization Forecast (J-NRUF) once a Jeopardy Condition has been declared for a specific NPA. Subsequent J-NRUFs shall be conducted by the CNA on a quarterly basis until 3 months before relief is implemented, unless otherwise directed by the Commission.

Accordingly, the CNA is providing the attached J-NRUF forms for completion by current and prospective CO Code Holders in NPAs 204 and 705 no later than **29 October 2010**.

Each CO Code Holder that holds any CO Code assignments or reservations in NPAs 204 and 705 or that intends to obtain any such CO Codes by 1 January 2016 must complete the corresponding J-NRUF Worksheet.

For the NPA 204 J-NRUF Worksheet, current and prospective CO Code Holders are required to provide the total quantity of assigned and reserved CO Codes assigned to them as of 1 January 2010 and 1 October 2010 as well as the total cumulative quantity of existing and future CO Codes forecast to be assigned and reserved as of the first day of each quarter for the next eight quarters, and then as of the first day of each year from 2013 up to and including 2016.

For the NPA 705 J-NRUF Worksheet, current and prospective CO Code Holders are required to provide the total quantity of assigned and reserved CO Codes assigned to

them as of 1 January 2010 and 1 October 2010 as well as the total cumulative quantity of existing and future CO Codes forecast to be assigned and reserved as of the first day of each quarter for the next two quarters, and then as of the first day of each year from 2012 up to and including 2016.

All completed J-NRUF forms must be returned to Suresh Khare of the CNA no later than **29 October 2010**. The e-mail address is:

All Code Holder inputs will be treated as confidential in accordance with the guidelines. Aggregate J-NRUF results for NPAs 204 and 705 will be posted on the CNA website at www.cnac.ca once the information has been consolidated.
