

## SUBJECT: CNA - CO Code Status data format change - New Pooled field

On the evening of **Thursday, 26 June 2025**, the CNA will be modifying the CO Code Status data, adding a "Pooled" field.

The new field will be titled "Pooled" and will be placed after the "Status" field. It is intended that the Pooled field ALWAYS be populated. The field indicates if the CO Code is a "pooled" (i.e., thousands-block pooling) code. The default for this field will be "N". This includes non-pooled assigned codes, unassigned (available) codes or various unassignable codes. Codes that are assigned and participating in Thousands-Block Pooling will have a "Y" in the Pooled field.

Below is a sample of a "friendly" html CO Code Status page showing the additional field.



Below is a sample of a Comma Separated Values (CSV) data file with CO Code data including the new Pooled field. CSV files for each NPA as well as the compressed .zip file containing all CO Code data will be updated to this format.
